

Special meeting of the mayor and council was held May 30, 2017, 6:30 p.m. at city hall. Presiding: Mayor Jennifer Brush. Council present: John Cary, John Bisnette, Devin Renken, Tonya Kuhn, Teri Cordill. Others present: Bruce Berkley, Josh Hofflinger, Vickie Oviatt, Christopher Chandler, Canaan Currence, and Allen Schweitzer.

Mayor Brush called the meeting to order for the purpose of discussing the swimming pool; street maintenance; park vandalism; and non-elected personnel.

Josh Hofflinger, city employee, presented information regarding pool vacuum prices from Swimtime. Option 1 - Kingshark 2 with swivel @ \$3994.00; Option 2 -Tigershark 2 @ \$2,194.00. Action was tabled.

Regarding the April 2, 2017 damages at the park, Bruce explained the proposed agreement between the city and the perpetrators. Tonya moved, seconded by Devin, to allow the mayor to sign the agreement with Christopher Chandler and Canaan Currence. Carried. Canaan gave the council a verbal apology that he was sorry he had vandalized the city fence post. Christopher and Canaan left the meeting. Allen Schweitzer arrived at the meeting on behalf of his son, Preston Schweitzer. Allen discussed the agreement and Preston's involvement. Mayor Brush explained that the agreement has been offered in lieu of proceeding with prosecution. She requested an answer from Allen by Monday, June 5, 2017.

Mayor Brush noted that on the city crew's list of projects that street sealing is included, along with street sweeping. Council requested that they be provided with a listing of the street sealing rotation schedule.

At 7:06 p.m., John Cary moved to recess into executive session for 45 minutes with the mayor and council present to discuss non-elected personnel. John B. seconded. Carried.
