Be It Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of DOWNS:

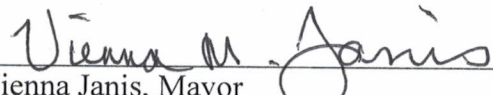
SECTION 1: That Section 14-212 of the Code of the City of Downs, Kansas is hereby amended to read as:

14-212 RESTRICTIONS ON PARKING

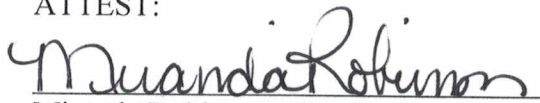
- a) It shall be unlawful to park any recreational vehicle, camper, trailer, travel trailer, boat trailer, house trailer, pole trailer, semi-trailer, special mobile equipment or motor home on any city street
- b) Upon approval by the city, parking of above items may be granted for a limited time due to an emergency situation.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect 30 days from and after the date of its approval and adoption as shown below and its publication in the official City newspaper.
