

ORDINANCE NO. 1016

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO WATER SERVICE AMENDING SECTION 15-225 OF THE ORDINANCE CODE OF THE CITY OF DOWNS, KANSAS AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREOF
(Published August 24, 2023)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DOWNS, KANSAS THAT:

Section 1. That Section 15-225 of the Ordinance Code of the City of Downs, Kansas be amended to read as follows:

15-225. WATER RATES AND CHARGES. Water rates and service charges shall be made monthly for water furnished to consumers through each separate meter by the city as follows:

First 2,500 gallons or less - \$34.00 minimum.
2,501 gallons to 12,500 gallons - \$5.80 per 1,000 gallons.
12,501 gallons to 50,000 gallons - \$6.30 per 1,000 gallons.
Over 50,000 gallons - \$6.80 per 1,000 gallons.
Users outside the city limits of the City of Downs, Kansas, - an additional \$22.00 minimum per monthly period.

Section 2. That Section 15-225 of the Ordinance Code of the City of Downs, Kansas, prior amendments thereto, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 3. That Ordinance 1004 of the Ordinance Code of the City of Downs, Kansas, prior amendments thereto, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed


Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper to be effective beginning the first billing cycle after October 1, 2023.

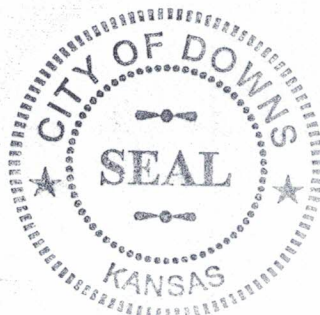
