A special meeting of the Mayor and Council was held December 30, 2025, 12:00 p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Vienna Janis presided. Council members present: John Cordill, Joyce Hake, Heather Hancock, and John Bisnette. Council not present: Collin Jones. Also present: Bruce Berkley, Brady Pound, Harry Colburn, and Miranda Robinson.

Mayor Janis called the special meeting to order for the purpose of conducting the Neighborhood Revitalization hearing and end of year business on behalf of the city to approve transfer requests, permits and licenses, and vouchers and payroll.

At 12:01 p.m. Mayor Vienna Janis opened the Neighborhood Revitalization hearing. No public comment was given either in writing or verbal. The hearing closed at 12:05 p.m.

Heather moved, John C. seconded, to approve the Neighborhood Revitalization Plan as presented by Osborne County. Motion carried with 3 ayes.

John C. moved, Joyce seconded, to approve Ordinance 1022 joining Osborne County Neighborhood Revitalization Plan. Motion carried with 3 ayes.

Joyce moved, Heather seconded, to allow the mayor to sign the interlocal agreement for the Osborne County Neighborhood Revitalization Plan. Motion carried with 3 ayes.

Heather moved, John C. seconded, to approve contractor's licenses 26-16 to 26-24. Motion carried with 3 ayes.

John Bisnette entered the meeting.

John C. moved, John B. seconded, to approve special use permits 26-16 to 26-20. Motion carried with 4 ayes.

John C. moved, Joyce seconded, to approve the transfer request from the Downs Fire Department in the amount of \$8,645.10 to the fire equipment reserve. Motion carried with 4 ayes.

Heather moved, John B. seconded, to approve the end of the year transfer from General to City Equipment Reserve in the amount of \$5,000. Motion carried with 4 ayes.

John C. moved, Joyce seconded, to approve vouchers as presented. Motion carried with 4 ayes.

With no further business, John C. moved, Heather seconded, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried with 4 ayes. The meeting adjourned at 12:15 p.m.
