Downs City Council met in regular session on Monday September 16, 2024, 5:30 p.m., at City Hall. Council members present: Heather Hancock, Collin Jones, John Cordill, and John Bisnette. Council not present: Devin Renken. Others present: Bruce Berkley, Harry Colburn, and Miranda Robinson. Mayor Vienna Janis called the meeting to order and led in the flag salute.

Minutes

Staff Reports

City Attorney Bruce Berkley gave notice of a Board of Zoning Appeals hearing on Thursday for variance for building a fence at 218 Blunt Street.

In the water report, Harry Colburn received a phone call from the water plant early that morning as there were generator issues again. A representative from Clifford Power will be out next week to look at it. It is believed the issue stems from a variance in voltage.

City Clerk Miranda Robinson stated the monthly financials were in her written report. She reports that the new hire started and things are going smoothly. She is working on the grant report for the neighborhood maintenance pilot program and they have three more applicants to be reimbursed.

Bruce Berkley and Collin Jones reported for the fire department as fire safety week is coming up. The fire department will go to Lakeside Elementary on October 10 to give a presentation.

New Business
