

A Special Council meeting was held at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 9, 2022 with Mayor Vienna Janis presiding. Council members present were Charlie Stevens, John Cordill, Heather Hancock. Not present were Devin Renken and Joyce Hake. Also present were Harry Colburn, Miranda Robinson, and Bruce Berkley.

Mayor Janis called the meeting to order. The call for the special meeting was read and signed.

Discussion was held on the purchase of a 1994 Chevy Kodiak Truck for \$10,000 out of Garden City. This vehicle has 19,000 miles and will come with an end gate and side extensions. The crew will utilize this truck for hauling trees, dirt, snow, and rock. This truck would replace the 1963 Chevy that has brake issues. Harry stated he would go down to Garden City this weekend to test drive and look the vehicle over to see if he approves it.

Charlie moved to allow the City Superintendent to purchase the 1994 Chevy Kodiak not to exceed \$10,000 upon sight approval by Harry, and to pay 80% from Special Highway Fund and 20% from City Equipment Reserve Fund. Heather seconded the motion. Motion carried with 3 ayes.

At 6:20 p.m. John moved to adjourn the meeting, Charlie seconded. Meeting adjourned.
