Downs City Council met in special session on Tuesday, September 10, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall. Council members present were John Bisnette, John Cordill, Collin Jones, and Heather Hancock. Not present: Devin Renken. Others present were Mayor Vienna Janis, City Clerk Miranda Robinson, City Attorney Bruce Berkley.

The special meeting call was read by Mayor Vienna Janis. The special meeting was to discuss the Downs Clinic building, moving the clinic to a temporary building at 620 Morgan Ave., building insurance, and building utility services.

It was reported that the moving from one building to the next is almost complete after a drop ceiling was installed over two rooms and doors installed. The medical staff believe they will be ready to open on Monday September 16 at 620 Morgan Ave. The council discussed the rent and utilities.
